

Site Management: General Recommendations

The Short Term Strategy 2006-2010:

Firstly; The executing of the most important interventions as:

- The visitors security (fixing barrier along the wall walk and all the axes of the visit).
- The interventions needed to insure the safety of the visitor agents the snakes and the other poison insect.
- The explication and indication panels of the site and it's monuments.
- The consolidation interventions needed to insure the stability of the buildings depending on the priorities drawn in the master plan.
- The removing of all the stones and rubbish goatherd inside the monuments and at the visit axes.
- The isolation of all the roofs of the monuments.

- The discussion with the concerning authorities about the enlarging of the natural protected zone of the site.
- The developing of the sosio-economic aspects to obtain the most possible benefits.
- The developing of the internet site of Al Marqab citadel to execute the best promotion for the site, through the mechanizing of the site visit reservation, publishing the annual program of the activities to be held...etc.
- The continuity with the international institutions and communities has some of the ancient documents of the site (the Hospital Knight organization, the Altar Knight, the international libraries and museums...etc).
- The call for an international Architectural design competition for the rehabilitation of the village and the Ottoman caravansary to be as a camp and royal resident
